- Establish and fund special library endowments

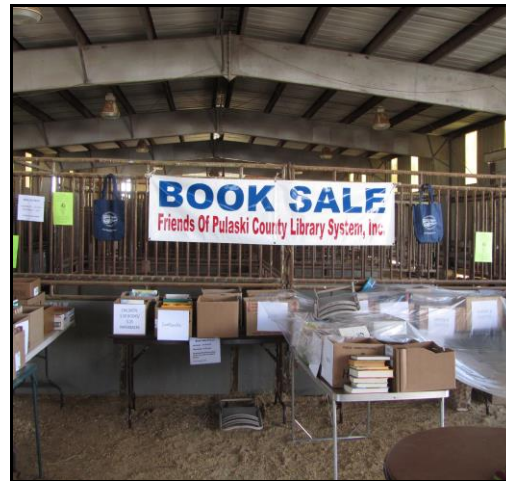
Meetings:
